

Stella Gallegos has worked in the field of sexual assault for 39 years and is a licensed independent social worker. As a Consultant/Trainer along with the New Mexico Coalition of Sexual Assault Programs, she provided Sexual Abuse trainings to employees, volunteers, and schools. She has provided mandatory training on child sexual abuse and sexual harassment for all Bishops and priests, employees and volunteers, CCD and CYO students of the Catholic Archdiocese of Santa Fe, Catholic Diocese of Las Cruces, and Catholic Diocese of Gallup. Stella assisted the Archdiocese in making sure treatment was available to the survivors of Sexual Abuse/Sexual Assault and their families, the person reporting the incident and the alleged perpetrator. She also provided child sexual abuse training to staff and volunteers of the Episcopal Diocese of the Rio Grande and the United Methodist Church.
