Crime Victims' Rights Week.**

In conjunction with our partners, the Guam Coalition Against Sexual Assault and Family Violence (GCASAFV) cordially extends an invitation to all students from K-5<sup>th</sup> Grade to enter the **National Crime Victim's Rights Week (NCVRW) Art Contest**. This year's theme is Serving Victims, Building Trust, and Restoring Hope.

All submissions must be received by March 31, 2016 at 5:00 pm. The public will be voting on the submitted artwork on April 9, 2016 at Micronesia Mall center court during our NCVRW Tabling event and outreach.

The winning artwork will be used in 3 publications: a background image in Voices of Victims/Survivors video, in a booklet comprised of crime victim/survivor's stories, and social media (i.e. GCASAFV website and/or Facebook). It will also be displayed at the outreach tabling event on Saturday, April 9, 2016 at the Micronesia Mall from 10:00AM – 2:00PM, center court for voting.

Rules:

1. Please submit one design on an 8"x14" piece of paper.
2. Design can be done in crayon, colored pencils or water color.
3. Design must include the colors yellow, orange and blue.
4. Art work must be accompanied with a submission/waiver form.
5. Submissions must be received no later than March 31, 2016 at 5:00 pm.
6. Submit all artwork to GCASAFV office in Hagatna.

Judging will be held on April 9, 2016 at the National Crime Victim's Rights Week outreach at Micronesia Mall, Center Court 10:00 am – 2:00 pm. The public will judge the art. First place and runner up will be announced.
