Presenter Biographies

ANDERSON, JANE

Jane brings extensive experience in prosecuting domestic violence, sexual violence, and human trafficking to her role as Attorney Advisor with AEquitas. Previously, as an Assistant State Attorney with Florida's 11th Judicial Circuit in Miami-Dade County, she played a key role in some of the state's first human trafficking cases, which often involved sexual assault, child abuse, and money laundering. As a founding member of the Miami-Dade State Attorney's Human Trafficking Unit and Task Force, Jane developed policies and procedures to better identify and assist trafficking victims while ensuring accountability for offenders through the use of digital evidence and creative charging decisions. She also served as Chief of Litigation for the Misdemeanor Domestic Violence Unit, where she trained new attorneys and oversaw the prosecution of domestic violence, stalking, and violations of civil protection orders.

Throughout her career, Jane has prosecuted a wide range of felony crimes, including homicide, kidnapping, sexual assault, and other violent offenses. With her courtroom experience and expertise in policy development, Jane now assists prosecutors and allied professionals in adopting a victim-centered, offender-focused approach to cases involving domestic violence, stalking, sexual violence, human trafficking, and elder abuse. She provides training, technical assistance, and resources on investigations, case analysis, trial strategy, and curriculum development.

PENTICO, KIM

Kim has dedicated her career to supporting survivors of sexual and domestic violence since 1990. She began her work in Kansas, spending over seven years with a local domestic violence program before joining the Kansas Coalition Against Sexual and Domestic Violence, where she spent another seven years advocating for change. Kim also contributed to the STOP Technical Assistance Project in Washington, DC, where she focused on providing support and guidance to organizations across the country. Throughout her career, Kim has worked to improve access to economic justice and long-term safety for survivors, striving to create lasting positive change in their lives.

SATTLER, VICTORIA

Victoria is a dedicated and accomplished Registered Nurse who has worked in emergency care at a Level 2 trauma center since 2006. She holds a PhD in Nursing, specializing in psychometrics, along with a Master's degree in Nursing, focusing on education. Victoria also earned a graduate certificate in Global Public Health, broadening her perspective on global healthcare challenges. As a Certified Emergency Nurse (CEN) and Trauma Certified Registered Nurse (TCRN), she is highly skilled in the fast-paced, high-pressure environment of emergency nursing. Her certification as a Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner for adults and adolescents (SANE-A) underscores her commitment to providing compassionate care for survivors of sexual assault.

Beyond her clinical work, Victoria has served as a nurse expert witness in malpractice cases related to emergency nursing, providing invaluable insights during legal proceedings. From 2010 to 2024, she taught future healthcare professionals at Washington State University College of Nursing. She currently co-teaches a clinical skills course for sexual assault nurse examiners, continuing her passion for nursing education and mentorship. Victoria's dedication to patient advocacy and nursing education continues to shape the profession and improve patient care.

Chad is a Tech Safety Senior Specialist with the National Network to End Domestic Violence (NNEDV), where he supports the Safety Net project focused on technology and gender-based violence.
