Human Trafficking and Stalking Awareness and Prevention Month Proclamation Signing & Presentation of Resolutions



GCASAFV in partnership with the Governor's Community Outreach – Federal Programs Office (GCO – FPO) and the US Attorney's Office, held the 2018 Human Trafficking & Stalking Awareness & Prevention Month Proclamation Signing & Resolution on January 10 at the Guam Museum Multi-Purpose Auditorium. Attorney General

Elizabeth Barrett-Anderson opened the event by recognizing the community's service providers and acknowledging that Guam is not immune to human trafficking. Lt. Governor Ray Tenorio presented and signed the Human Trafficking and Stalking proclamation declaring January as National Anti-Slavery & Human Trafficking Awareness & Prevention Month and National Stalking Awareness & Prevention Month. Vice-Speaker Therese Terlaje, Senator Frank Aguon Jr. and Senator Regine Biscoe Lee presented this year's Legislative Resolutions. Representatives from Guam’s direct-service providers served on a panel to answer attendees’ questions.
